Constitution

1. The Club is called 'Nettlebed Folk Club' hereafter known as 'the Club'
2. The object of the Club will be to advance, improve, develop and maintain the appreciation of folk music in all its aspects with the provision of public concerts and other such musical activities as may be deemed consistent with the character of the Club.
3. The Club shall be run by volunteers as a non-profit organisation and all funds will be devoted to the furtherance of the objects stated above. (Including donations to other causes that will further the Club's achievement of the above). As a contingency, the Club should maintain sufficient funds to cover its guaranteed contract commitments for the following 12 months.
4. Membership is free of charge. Members shall consist of up to 10 Full & Founding Members and any number of Associate Members. Only Full & Founding Members are entitled to attend and vote at any meeting of whom four may constitute a quorum. New Full Members may be appointed by a two-thirds majority of the Full & Founding Members but must have at least 5 years Associate membership. All members will receive an advance programme of the series of events each season. The Full & Founding Members are empowered to run and finance the day to day business of the Club, arrange the programme and to fix an appropriate charge for these activities. The Club's business year will end on April 5th each year.
5. No member of the Club shall receive any remuneration or other financial benefit from the Club apart from occasional musical services or the reimbursement of expenses properly incurred on behalf of the Club.
6. The Full & Founding Members may change or add to the Club's constitution. The Club may at any time be dissolved by a resolution passed by a two-thirds majority of the Full & Founding Members present at a Special Meeting. All remaining Club assets at the date of dissolution shall be donated to a suitable organisation or organisations who have objects similar to those of the Club.
