NOVEMBER

- 1 Cara Dillon** – *“Twenty years ago, when I released my first album, I had no idea the incredible musical journey I was about to embark upon. All I knew was I wanted to sing my heart out. For me something truly magical happened when I met Sam, like a meeting of souls. We hoisted the sails and set off on our musical adventure, releasing ‘Cara Dillon’ to the wind. We both sat back with innocent, wide-eyed wonder, amazed at how it connected*
